SWA JUMPSEAT ALERT



We have previously communicated that Southwest Airlines is transitioning to a new reservation system. Tomorrow, May 9th, the associated change of using myIDTravel for all jumpseat reservations will go into effect. Beginning tomorrow morning, walk up listings will no longer be accepted and the 800 number will be deactivated. [MyIDTravel](#) will be the only way to list for a Southwest Airlines jumpseat, and you can do so now for travel tomorrow and beyond.

The procedure is identical to the one currently used by American, Virgin America, and JetBlue.
