Negotiating Update

Fellow JetBlue ALPA pilots,

The Negotiating Committee met with management and the mediator this week for negotiations scheduled to start on Monday afternoon and end with a full day of bargaining on March 2. In accordance with the mediator's directive and as part of his effort to clear out all issues beyond the core disputes over pay, both sides bargained over and submitted packages for the resolution of Scheduling issues, Check Airman pay, QDL pay, International override, and per diem. Despite some narrowing of differences, we were ultimately unable to resolve all the issues in the package because Company demands for scheduling relief as part of this package offset any gains for the pilots.

Additionally, the full day of bargaining scheduled on Friday was cancelled because the Company requested that it be allowed to return to New York early due to the impending weather. After three years of bargaining in which the Company is making record profits coupled with this extraordinary bargaining environment, we feel that the approach taken by the Company in its package proposal is unreasonable.

The next negotiating session has been scheduled for April 10–13 with the mediator.
